Career

Hans-Joerg Rudloff started his career in 1965 with Credit Suisse. From 1968 - 1979 he was with Kidder Peabody & Company. In 1980 became Deputy Chairman of Credit Suisse First Boston and in 1989 Chairman & CEO. HJR was elected in 1986 to the Executive Board of Credit Suisse, where he oversaw all security business. HJR was Chairman of MC-Banque Bruxelles Lambert, Eastern Europe (1994 – 1998) and Vice Chairman of Sandoz (1995). Between 1998 – 2014 Hans-Joerg Rudloff was Chairman of Barclays' Investment Bank PLC.

Further career steps:

Vice Chairman, Head of the Remuneration Committee, Member of the Audit Committee and Member of Chairman's Committee of Novartis AG (1995 – 2011). Member of the Board and Chairman of the Audit Committee, Vice Chairman of the Board (2006 – 2011) and re-appointed as an independent director in 2018 until February 2022 of Rosneft Oil Company. Chairman of the International Capital Market Association, ICMA (2005 – 2011). Chairman of Bluebay Asset Management Group. Member of the Advisory Board of Landeskreditbank Baden-Württemberg, of Munich Security Conference, TBG Ltd (Thyssen Bornemisza Group); Member of the Board of Guardian Capital Group Ltd, International Center of Monetary and Banking Studies (ICMB).
